Remaining Loyal

Big Idea

Jesus commends His church for persevering in spite of persecution but warns them not to compromise with an idolatrous and immoral culture.

Revelation 2:12-17

Description of Christ: has the sharp two-edged sword

Commendation: holding fast Christ's name, not denying their faith

Rebuke: false teaching

Solution: repent

Consequence of disobedience: war against them with the sword of Christ's mouth

Promise for faithful: will be given hidden manna and a white stone with a new name on it

Satan's throne

Antipas

Balaam

Repent

Hidden manna

White stones

Jesus opposes false teaching that encourages compromise with a non-Godly culture.

Jesus judges by the power of His word.
