Big Idea

Wake up and wise up calls have to be heeded.

Revelation 3:1-6

Description of Christ: has the seven spirits of God
and the seven stars

Commendation: 0

Rebuke: dead works

Solution: keep the Word and repent

Consequence of disobedience: Christ will come
like a thief

Promise for faithful: will be clothed in white garments;
name never blotted out of the book of life; name
confessed before God and angels

Theologies:

Human reputation means nothing compared to God's assessment of our spiritual condition.

A dying church must take decisive action to be restored to spiritual health.

Jesus promises eternal recognition and security for the faithful minority.

Applications:

We must not rely on our past victories to make up for our present spiritual slumber.

A few faithful followers can help a dying church.

As a church we must not mesh with the ungodly culture.

The goal is to be Christlike and not culture like.

What matters most is not our religious reputation before people but our standing before God, which is related to how we live.
