Philadelphia – A Powerhouse of Little Strength

Big Idea

When you remain obedient and true to Jesus' name
your small strength becomes great power.

Revelation 3:7-13

Description of Christ: the holy one, the true one, who
has the keys of David

Commendation: patiently enduring, keeping God's
word and not denying his name

Rebuke: 0

Solution: hold fast to what you have

Consequence of disobedience: 0

Promise for faithful: will be made a pillar in the
temple of God, inscribed with the names of God,
the new Jerusalem, and Christ

Theologies:

Jesus has sovereign control over who gets into the kingdom of God.

Jesus' acceptance of His people cannot be reversed by the world's rejection of them.

God's true people will be publicly identified and vindicated in the end.

Christ will protect His people from spiritual attack even though they may suffer physical persecution.

The greatest eternal reward possible is a permanent place in the presence of God.

Applications:

Success in our faith journey has to do with our obedience to Christ NOT how we look or appear to the world around us.

As believers we are not exempt from suffering and persecution but we are protected from demonic assault.
